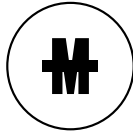

Armagnac, Brandy, Calvados & Cognac

What is it? Grape brandy using generally highly acidic and unusable for wine making grapes, distilling once in Armagnac's case, and twice in Cognac's, to then be rested and mellowed, in the most hallowed of French Chateaus. Brandy from around the world is also made in similar fashions, but Cognac and Armagnac still stand alone, as the iconic symbol of true style and wealth, adhering to strict rules of production. Calvados is made in a similar fashion but from apples and pears, then aged in French oak again, for added depth and richness. Deep, complex, and delicious, sample some of the finest Cru's here!

Irish whiskey has a smoother finish as opposed to the smoky, earthy overtones common to Scotch whisky, which come largely from drying the malted barley using peat smoke.

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Cachaca/Agricole

What is it? A style of rum endemic to Brazil in the case of Cachaca, and the French colonies for Agricole Rhum, however many methods of indigenous Agricole spirit production exist around the planet. Made from freshly cut and pressed sugarcane juice, fermented often within hours from cutting, this funky and bright spirit is packed with flavor. Notes of cut grasses and bright punchy fruits, the best aged varieties rival the world's best whiskies and cognacs for a place at the elite sipping table.

Unaged grape brandy from South America, generally using the Quebranta, Torrontel, Muscatel, Mollar and Albilla grapes. Originating in the 16th century in Peru and blossoming into Chile, causing quite the controversy over the Pisco Sour, both countries national cocktail. Dry and bracing, with fruit and flowers on the palate and nose, and a distinctly clean and crisp finish.

Spiced Rum

What is it? Generally, a lightly aged rum pulled from the barrel around the 2yr mark and then modified with often sugar, natural or unnatural spices and flavouring agents, as well as colourings and additives. We attempt to strive away from the more artificially spiced rums, and tend to stock rums that rely on only minimal addition of sugar to the finished distillate. Regardless, sipping is so easy its almost criminal!

Tequila

What is it? Distilled from the Weber Azul (Blue Agave), this luscious, rich and often misunderstood spirit is a truly terroir driven experience. Each Agave plant takes from 7-25 years to mature, and each bottle of tequila takes, 1 Agave. Mother Nature is most efficient. With only 4 certified regions to produce Tequila in, a large portion hails from Tequila town, whose history runs deep and intricate, with other certified producing regions being Tamaulipas, Nayarit, Michoacán, and Guanajuato. Each distillery carries a specific NOM or Number of Origins of Manufacture in brief. Fruity, bursting with mineral and vegetal flavours and elegant smoke, loose yourself in a flight of fine sipping tequila's tonight!

Mezcal/Agave Distillates

What are they? Distilled from a combination of agave plants from over 130 different varieties and sub-species from the highly regarded Blue Agave. There are also a rich and varied range of styles of Agaves and Mezcal, and we unfortunately see only a handful here, but some of the best are here on view. The biggest difference between these and Tequila is the method of production and distillation, with Mezcal and its varieties being cooked in the earth on lava rocks, and then distilled in clay pots, whereas Tequila usually involves the steaming of the agave before distillation in copper pot stills. Deep, smokey, fruity and funky, with spices and mineral layers. Truly unique.

Supple and luscious, dry and floral, sweet and bracing, spicy and earthy, these are the link in all your drinks, the pizzazz in your Martini, and the balance to your Bronx. Don't be shy to try neat or with soda, and drink light and refreshing!
